1.0 Convene Meeting:

- 1.1 Call to Order: Meeting was called to order by Vice-Chairman Dan Walters at 7:00 p.m.

- 5.0 Staff Report: Chief Gray gave an update on his follow-up on the Music Hall. In discussion with the Manager it was determined that the bar is likely the cause of overcrowding. There are separate occupancy numbers for the bar and the hall, but the bar traffic is more fluid and harder to control. He will continue to monitor closely.

He worked with the broker to determine best pricing for the Water Tender. There were many offers received. We accepted the offer of \$40,000 and will be receiving the down payment for \$4,000. The broker will buy and then finance the amount for a small department in Oklahoma. No offers yet on the Rescue. Chief Gray has done no additional research on a Type 6.

County Health has been planning in preparation for dealing with the Corona Virus. We are maintaining additional records regarding exposures and we are prepared with extra supplies.

The Active Shooter Drill is this Sunday, March 8th. It will be held at Roaring Camp as originally planned, with classroom portions at San Lorenzo Valley Elementary in the morning. Each volunteer department has committed engines and staffing.

Chief Gray is hoping to attend the Annual Wildland Convention on March 23 through 26. He has read through the registration and it is good relevant material and topics. The convention fee is \$400 and there would also be additional hotel costs. Director Richmond suggested talking to CalFire regarding any plans they have to attend. Director Anderson felt this would be a good proactive training for our community. The board members were agreeable to his attendance.

The new Water Tender will need a radio when it goes into service. Chief Gray proposes purchasing a new on at an approximate cost of \$2,600 as opposed to placing the existing older one in it. There was some discussion that followed and the board was in agreement of purchasing the new equipment.
